- 5. Anti raging committee is working well.
- 6. There is sufficient provision of add on courses.

C. 79 % of the Stakeholders said that

- 1. System of examination is very good.
- 2. There is sufficient horizontal mobility to the students
- 3. Work is made available whenever is required.

Suggestions:

1. Office should be modified and computerized.



Assessment of the Teacher by Students Conclusion & Suggestion

• Conclusion:
