Content of The Right Education

* Education is not a privilege. It is a human right.

- The right to education is legally guaranteed for all without any discrimination
- States have the obligation to protect, respect and fulfil the right to education.
- There are ways to hold States accountable for violation or deprivation or deprivation of the right to education.

"Education is not a privilege of the rich and well-to-do; it is an inalienable right of every child. Provision of basic education free of costs is a core obligation of States."




Where is the right to education guaranteed?
 International human right law guaranteed the right to education. The Universal Declaration on Human Rights adopted in 1948, proclaims in article 26:

- Why is the right to education fundamental?
 it is an entrenched right. It lifts marginalised group out of Realising. It is an indispensable means of realising other rights.

What is the Content of the right to education?
 The right to education encompasses both entitlement freedoms including the

- Right to free and compulsory primary education
- Right to available and accessible secondary education (including technical and vocational education and training) made progressively free
- Right to equal access to higher education on the basis of Capacity made.
- Right to fundamental education for those who have not received or completed primary education.



What are the human rights?
 Human rights are inherent to all human beings regardless of nationality, sex, racial or ethnic origin, colour, religion, language, or any other status. They cannot be given or taken away.
 Human rights are the foundation for freedom, justice and peace in the world.
